

Fabric Requirements for The Snowy Days Table Runner (48" x 25")





Blender 1 (d blue print)

Hero Fabric (red berries)

Blender 2 (red)

Solid (green)



Background (white)



Table Runner Requirements (48" x 25")

0.25m Hero Fabric
0.75m Blender 1
0.75m Blender 2
0.25 m Solid (fat quarter is fine)
1m Background
1.25m backing fabric & a piece of wadding 52" x 30"

Cutting Out The Snowy Days Table Runner

Note 1: WOF means width of fabric – this is a strip cut from one selvedge to the other across the fabric.

Note 2: This quilt has 5 blocks (A, C, D, AD 1 and AD2) – keep the cut out pieces grouped in their blocks.

Hero

Cut (3) 6 1/2" squares (Block A)

Blender 1

Cut (24) 3 ½" squares (Block A) Cut (4) 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles (Block C) Cut (4) 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangles (Block C)

Cut (2) 3 ½" x 12 ½" rectangle (AD2)

Blender 2

Cut (8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (Block C)

Cut (2) 2 5/8" squares (Block D)

Cut (8) 3 ½" squares (AD1)

<u>Solid</u>

Cut (6) 2 5/8" squares (Block D)

Cut (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (AD1)

Cut (1) 2 5/8" x 20" rectangle (AD2)

Background.

Cut (12) 3 ½" squares (Block A)

Cut (16) 3 ½" squares (AD1)

Cut (12) 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles (Block A)

Cut (4) 2 1/2" squares (Block C)

Cut (4) 2 5/8" squares (Block D)

Cut (2) 2 5/8" x 20" rectangles (AD2)

Cut (4) 4" squares cut on the diagonal (Block C)

Cut (6) 3" squares cut on the diagonal (Block C)

Cut (4) 3" squares cut on the diagonal (Block D)
